I am currently preparing a roster for lawn mowing duties for our surrounds. I thank all of those who have put their hands up to help out on this roster. Duty is on Fridays at about 8am, 2 mowers do one green surround each and help out anywhere required. Morning tea at 9am, all done. If anyone else can help out here please let me know.

Roster commences in September until April and you will only have 2 or 3 shifts over that period.

BOARD MATTERS

We are continuing with our plan to replace the worn, tattered synthetic carpet between the Rose and Members greens. Not sure when this work will be done, but, that area will be closed for a few days when it is.

We will also replace the droppers into the ditches surrounding the grass greens towards the end of September.

All mechanical green keeping equipment has been sent away for servicing and will be in top condition for the season ahead.

We are investigating the possibility of an insurance claim under our Business Interruption Insurance for our financial losses during Covid. Our losses have been substantial and a successful claim would be an excellent result for our club. This will be ongoing for some time but we will pursue this until the end.

PENNANT BOWLS

The 2021-22 bowls is coming around very quickly and I will detail below what our team allocations are for the season.

MIDWEEK

We have teams in Divisions 1, 2, 3, 4 North and

Most of this is really good for us, as, unlike last season we will not have 2 teams in Division 1 and no team in Division be \$6 each. This assumes that Weekend pennant afternoon 2. This provides a very good pathway for players to progress through the Divisions.

The problematic team is Division 4 South who have been placed with teams from Alexandra, Eildon, Seymour, Seymour VRI and Euroa. I don't believe we can complain about the Seymour or Euroa teams as they have always been a part of our competition.

When the first version of these playing areas pennant draws came out I wrote to the Match Committee and told them in no uncertain terms that we would not expect our bowlers to travel to Alexandra and Eildon.

We were led to believe that our concerns would be listened to and changes made. Not so.

Our problem is that we require 48 bowlers every week to fill our first 4 teams. We presently have about 67 names on the list to play Midweek pennant.

If we drop that team we will have about 19 players not getting a game.

The Midweek selectors met with the board on Monday and all options were discussed. In the end it was decided that we should proceed in the following manner. We have advised the CGM that we accept the decision regarding our Details to come. team placement and that we will select our team, and, if the selected players do not want to play we will forfeit. A meeting of players most likely to be affected will be called in the near future to discuss the situation.

WEEKEND PENNANT

Once again, this team allocation is a fairly satisfactory result for our club. We have teams in Divisions 1,2,3,4 and 2 in Division 6. We did attempt to move one of our 2 Division 6 teams to Division 5, but, we were not successful. With our team allocations we require 88 players every week, which is a tough ask. We currently have about 85 names as well as several emergencies. There are also a number of our new members who we believe will also play.

There will also be opportunities for midweek players to fill in for Saturday pennant if they wish to do so.
