Club Events 2021 / 2022 - Conditions of Play

Dress code : Dress code for Club Championship events will be casual up to but not including the Grand Final unless otherwise requested by the Match Committee.

Green : Matches to be played on mutually acceptable green / rink, unless directed by the Match Committee. If players can't agree, decide by toss of coin.

- Results : The result of each match is to be entered as soon as possible after the match has been played.
- Handicaps : These are currently being reviewed and changed to fit in with Bowls Victoria guidelines. Some members may notice quite a change from previous years.
- Entry fee: The entry fee for these events is \$7 per player per event. This should be paid on entry, or at the time the first round match is played. Please enclose the money in an envelope with your name and event being entered clearly written on the envelope.
- Rounds : The date for the completion of each round is indicated on the draw sheet. Failure to comply with these dates (without approval from the Match Committee) may result in both players being disqualified.
